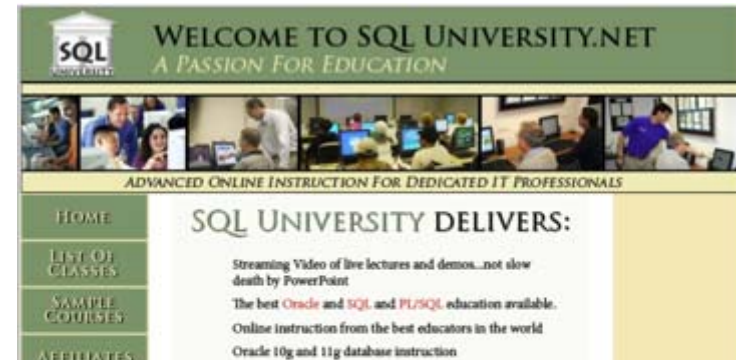

- Continue clause in PL/SQL
